**LOCAL RULE  
COUNTY COURTS AT LAW  
FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS**


Effective September 1, 1999, all civil cases, except condemnation cases, are ORDERED to mediate their disputes prior to the Court commencing a final trial on the merits. The responsibility for scheduling and conducting such mediation will be on the parties or their representatives; however, the appropriate Court will sign Orders to compel same when requested.


This Rule supplements and is in addition to Rule 3.40 - Settlements-Civil Cases-of the Local Rules of Court of County Courts at Law of Fort Bend County, Texas.


Within seven days of receipt of an Answer to the Plaintiff's Petition the Plaintiff's attorney will notify the Defendant's attorney of this Order.

All attorneys will certify to the appropriate Court that mediation has taken place when a request for trial setting is filed. The trial request and certification to be in writing.
